.7:35 PM	<ul> <li>Update from Principal Mukai</li> <li>Graduation, June 6 9:30 am Eagle Bank arena.</li> <li>Very successful year: Top 10 in US News and World Report for HS in VA; Highest test scores in state of VA and in Fairfax are 1 or 2 in every category. Track team won states. Cappies nominations. Band performing at VMAA</li> <li>Timing graduation day: students there at 8 am. Doors open at 8:30 am. Robinson ran 1:46 min long and they are 35 kids smaller than us. Schools have hard 2-hour cap.</li> <li>Question about Superintendent commissioning a zoning study.
