	 Currently in session through 2/22 Passed bi-annual budget in 2024 session, will go through 2026 Over \$1b in surplus, said they would dedicate that to (1) water quality improvement efforts, Chesapeake Bay, (2) modernizing I81, and (3) program for military families In December they had \$1b surplus again, re-evaluating where to invest those funds Making historic investments in public schools and teacher pay, but there's still more work to do, remains a top priority Snow Removal – plowing is managed by VDOT, responsibility for sidewalks varies, VDOT snow ploy map https://plow4va.vdot.virginia.gov/public/map Status of Governor Youngkin's proposal - \$50m in scholarship vouchers to private schools, going through appropriation process currently Rolling Rd & Grigsby Intersection – VDOT found it qualifies for red light, but has to be paid for by the County, request needs to be made to the County, PTSA could help advocate for that Affordable Housing Plans in Springfield – connect us to Supervisor Lusk to talk about what's happening locally 703-539-2066; Email: delktran@house.virginia.gov; Newsletter: https://bit.ly/TranNewsletter
