	<ul> <li>Kelley &amp; Tanika are part of WIMS PTA – FFX CTY proposed budget to eliminate all after-school activities across middle schools in the county, pulling together advocacy plan, meeting on March 11<sup>th</sup>, everyone is welcome, virtual and in-person at WIMS library</li> <li>Elimination of all HS crossing guards – recent roundtable, uncertain of current status, may replace with police, will follow up</li> <li>Community changes due to updates at the Federal level – how can we support people, can have social events, open to ideas; Liz Alstatt – county is looking at eliminating roughly 208 positions, not as many opportunities as a result, county has a lot of resources available (emotional, financial, etc.), has link for resource page on PTSA website, and dropped in chat</li> <li>PTSA is an advocacy organization – encouraging people to share information and provide opportunities for people to advocate where appropriate, budget cuts, school lunch program cuts, there's a lot to be educated on, please review advocacy materials we're sharing and send add'I items our way to help bridge any gaps in information</li> <li>Current head of National PTA is former parent of WSHS student, will be retiring next month, and looking to do something to honor him and his contributions</li> </ul>
