7:35 PM	<ul> <li>Treasurer's Report</li> <li>The previously reported balance in the PTSA's bank account as of March 2, 2025 was \$6,862.31</li> <li>Since the last treasurer's report: 27 more members joined the PTSA (\$250.20), the final PSAT fundraiser purchases were deposited into our account (\$149.87), we received several shop-to-give donations (\$21.67), and we paid for our insurance renewal (-\$343.78)</li> <li>The current balance in the PTSA's bank account as of April 7, 2025 is \$6940.27</li> </ul>

7:50 PM	<ul> <li>Fairfax budget process, including highlights from the town hall last week</li> <li>Board of Supervisors adopts an advertised budget, along with tax increase amount, for discussion</li> <li>Budget is funded by 2 things: Property taxes and State money</li> <li>State allows localities to raise money, meals tax is only option currently, gap in proposed budget and what would be needed to fully fund the collective bargaining agreement for teachers, the additional funds could bridge that gap, if they can't bridge the gap, would need to make cuts elsewhere</li> <li>There's no easy solution, will be a lot of budget pressure this year</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Richard raised the fact that the county is going to eliminate HS crossing guards in the budget, to keep it would need to raise salaries in order to get people, or they can replace them with police – general consensus among the group was that the crossing guards are more efficient then the police in managing safety and traffic</li> </ul>
