7:45 PM	PTSA Updates • Congrats to PTSA Scholarship for Success winners Malia McGarry and Hunter Sweeney; Thanks to the Scholarship and Awards committee chaired by Julie Cabus • Treasurer Report: PREVIOUS BANK BALANCE as of May 6, 2025 was \$7,065.78; MAY TRANSACTIONS - we received a few shop-to-give donations (\$11.42), and we paid for the catered Teacher Appreciation Week lunch (\$3000); JUNE TRANSACTIONS (PLANNED) - The PTSA will be awarding two students with a Scholarship for Success (\$500 each), paying state dues to the Virginia PTA (\$221.25), and the remaining dues for this school year to the FCCPTA (\$14.75); BANK BALANCE as of May 31, 2025 was \$4,077.20. • Approval of Minutes of May 2025 Meeting - approved • Update on School Budget: County gave some money to fund some teacher pay increases, but not enough to fully fund all increases that they bargained for, school board will have to allocate resources, raises may not be as plentiful, schools were directed to use some of their allocated money to support classrooms in specific areas, added on a meal tax that will provide add'l revenue, there was an increase in the budget, but many were not happy with the overall outcome, they did agree to continue to fund high school crossing guards, which benefits WSHS directly • Clarification on School Boundary maps: current maps just focus on specific criteria, not offered as proposed new boundaries
