7:45 PM	<p>Treasurer Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently have 273 PTSA members (18 net new) • Bank balance was \$5,336.82 on December 31, 2025 • Through January we received: \$52.86 in membership dues, and \$1.19 in Givebacks • Bank balance on February 1, 2026, was \$5,390.87
7:47 PM	<p>Guest Speaker: Erik Gordon, FCPS Chief of Facilities Services and Capital Programs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jessica Gillis, Executive Director for Capital Improvement and Planning was also on the call • Boundary Review Update – review was completed, no changes for West Springfield, next review cycle will be looking at schools under and over capacity to make recommendations going into 2027, some minor adjustments at the elementary level were made, and will be reviewed again in 2027 • Placement Process – online student transfer applications are accepted 2/1 to 6/1, 3 types of requests, (New HS curriculum – 2/1 to 5/1 deadline, Renewals – 2/15 to 4/1 deadline, Initial requests – 3/1 to 6/1 deadline); notification of requests can take 2 – 3 weeks, WSHS is closed to transfers due to over capacity

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How is overcrowding at WSHS being addressed – staff are working with admin on space needs, accommodating through increasing the use of classrooms, adding temporary classrooms (4 trailers), future work may include converting spaces to classrooms, no boundary changes were made as a result, and they are projected to continue to be over capacity • How are we predicting and planning for incoming people, as well as from Irving, and managing to that – transfers (confirming residency and that they qualify to transfer), cohorts do get smaller, look at birth rates per year, kindergarten migration, population trends, new residential development within the county, look at net migration patterns (different from transfers) whether that's relocations or military families, the trends have been decreasing in recent years, WSHS net migration was 70, lower than the last several years, see link for dashboard https://www.fcps.edu/facilities-planning-future/facilities-and-membership-dashboards • Are there other options than trailers or other tools in your tool bag for helping a school of this size – modulars/temporary trailers, ability to adjust programs based on capacity • In regard to the split feeders to Braddock and WSHS, Keene Mill and Sangster (?), will those be re-evaluated again to help with the overcrowding – will be looked at during comprehensive review with decision to be made in January 2027, was pushed out to get more community engagement • Putting together a plan for AP Centers for middle schools, will consider trends and who should return to their base school, will still have a transfer requirement
